COUNSELOR'S GUIDELINES

A counselor's first priority is to **help campers to become more like Jesus**. Be a model to show them how to be a selfless servant, and help them understand when they are not.

As a cabin counselor, you should only give counsel to the campers in your cabin.

If you observe a situation that needs a counselor's help, please go to the cabin counselor that is responsible for the particular camper(s).

If you are not able to resolve a particular situation, please take the situation to one of the head counselors.

Please observe all of the camp rules as you are being a model for campers.

A cabin counselor must be present at all times when a camper is in your cabin.

As a cabin counselor your daily responsibilities are:

- a. Help your campers clean and decorate the cabins.
- b. Help organize a morning devotional during cabin inspections.
- c. Make sure all of your campers attend all of the Camp Tanda events, including getting up and getting to bed.
- d. Help with skits.
- e. Make sure that all of your campers take showers.
- f. All counselors are to be in the cabin at lights out.
- g. Know where your campers are at all times.

Cabin counselor free time is from 10:15 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Counselors will remain on Camp Tanda grounds. (Suggestion: use this time to shower, sleep, read a book, take a walk, etc.) Wednesday there will be "off camp" activities for the counselors.

As a cabin counselor, be quick to listen and slow to give counsel.
